This will take place at an exciting event-packed day at Seething Airfield on Saturday September 5th. All are welcome - and there's loads to do. For more information see www.seething-airfield.com and keep an eye on the local press.

How do you go about fund raising?

Simple.

Just grab the mascot teddy for your organisation (only one please - not one per person!), and you make and fit a suitable parachute to your teddy. Please note - teddies should be no taller than 12" so we can fit more than one in the aircraft!

Then, copy the attached sponsor forms, and distribute them out to people who can gain sponsorship on your mascots behalf.

Come along to Seething Airfield on Saturday September 5th, get a luggage label and attach it securely to your mascot. Write the following information on the label:

- ✓ Mascot Name
- ✓ Organisations Name and Telephone Number
- ✓ Estimated total amount of sponsorship
- ✓ Organisation to which this money is going towards

Make sure you tell loads of people about it and drag them along to the event as well.

Your Teddy Mascot will be given a certificate to prove they really have performed a parachute jump.

All you then need to do is to go and get your people to collect your sponsor money!
